Hartford Schools

The first CTWAC Model UN was held at Hartford Public High School in 1952. Today, our thriving partnership with Hartford schools is our priority. Hartford students participate free of charge and are offered tailored after-school MUN prep workshops.



Curriculum Development

The Council has also developed a robust Model UN curriculum and teaching tools for educators to use in Model UN clubs, simulations, and directly in the classroom. Many schools have developed entire classes based on this curriculum.



Trip to the United Nations in NYC

Each year, students travel to New York City to tour the U.N., for meetings with the diplomats from the countries they will represent. This critical experience helps students understand how their countries approach global issues and draft resolutions.



Student Run

The program is entirely high school student run. Unlike many other programs, students choose the topics they will be debating, participate in leadership training, and serve as committee officers at the culminating conference.
