Hartford Schools

The CTWAC Model UN was first held at Hartford Public High School in 1952. Today, Hartford students participate at no charge and receive tailored after-school MUN prep workshops.



Curriculum Development

The Council developed a robust Model UN curriculum and tools for educators to use in Model UN clubs, simulations, and in the classroom. Many schools have developed entire classes based on this curriculum.



Trip to the United Nations in NYC

Students travel to the UN Missions in New York City and meet diplomats from countries they will represent. This critical experience helps students understand how countries approach global issues and draft resolutions.

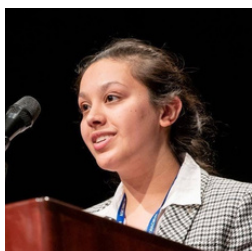


Student Run
